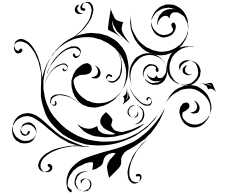

FRANCES WEBB

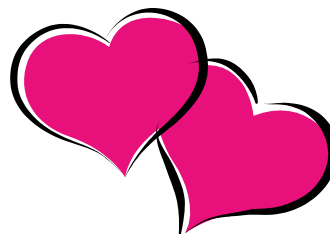
Frances Webb was born in New Mexico one fall October day. She has two sisters that live in Florida.

VALENTINE'S DAY—February 14th—Chilly from Ol' Man Winter? Well



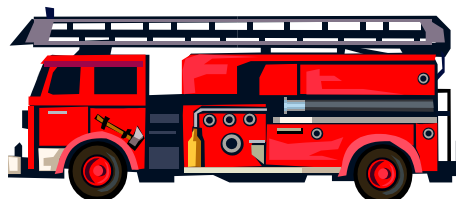
